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SCHOOL UNIFORM

Items with the school logo are available via the School Trends website [www.stparent.co.uk the link can be found on the school website] and are demarcated with this symbol *.

We hope that school clothes are tidy, practical and appropriate for school life. The school colour is bottle green. Governors and parents have agreed that the following basic dress code is desirable:

- Bottle green school sweatshirt, cardigan or jumper (with* or without logo),
- Polo shirt (with* or without logo), white shirt or blouse,
- Black or grey trousers, skirt or pinafore (please no jean-style trousers, leggings or jogging bottoms),
- Green and white checked or striped dresses may be worn during the Summer Term from April to July,
- Black sensible shoes (not trainers, open-toed, sling-backs or high heeled shoes). Plain, practical black boots may be worn in the Autumn Term when the weather is inclement.
- Grey, black, white or green tights or socks (preferably not other colours)
- We encourage children to wear hats and sunscreen on hot, sunny days. Please refer to our Sun Protection Policy.

Apart from simple earrings in pierced ears, children should not wear jewellery. Watches may be worn, but these must be the child's sole responsibility.

Long hair [shoulder length and longer] should be tied back in a plait or ponytail.

PE KIT

Children should keep their kit at school all week and it will be sent home every half term and holiday for washing and to allow the fit to be checked. We ask that kit bags are small and easy to store.

The required kit consists of:

- White t-shirt with school logo*,
- Green PE shorts*,
- Outdoor PE Kit – Black tracksuit trousers and black/bottle green tracksuit top (with* or without logo),
- Swimming costume or trunks for swimming (please note that loose swimming shorts are not permitted) - **Goggles are not allowed unless for medical reasons.**

No footwear is worn for gymnastics and multi-skills.

For outdoor sessions, children will need running trainers.

For safety reasons children with long hair must have it tied back and watches and earrings must be removed.

All uniform should be clearly named. Staff will make every effort to return named clothing to their owner but can take no responsibility for unnamed items.

BOOK BAGS

It is requested that parents buy their child a book bag when they come to school to carry books, notes, homework etc.

As we have limited cloakroom space, only one small rucksack type bag should be used in Key Stage 2. Children may still use book bags in Key Stage 2.
